Providing it ahead of the visit will be requested. ● Masks to be worn by all Creekside staff when moving around the building ● Session leader, will try and remain at least 1m away from group members where possible 	Low

					<ul style="list-style-type: none">● All other members of staff, volunteers and any other visitors should remain at least 1m from group members● Building will be well ventilated with open windows and doors when possible. This will need to be adapted during cold or wet weather by closing external doors and some windows.● Groups of up to 6 to move around the building when possible● Instruct all school adults and pupils to wash hands thoroughly before lunch and after handling artefacts● tables, benches, sinks, door handles and toilet flushes will be cleaned at the end of each session● Creekside Discovery Centre will be professionally cleaned on a regular basis● All Creekside Centre staff will carry out a lateral flow test before attending work once or twice a week depending on how many days they work (-1 test before 2 days work, 2 tests before more than 2 days work).● If a member of Creekside Centre staff tests positive for Covid-19, all school groups they have interacted with since their last negative Covid-19 test will be immediately contacted and notified
